

SCHLEY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
Thursday, July 16, 2015

The Schley County Board of Commissioners held their regularly scheduled monthly meeting July 16, 2015. Those present were Chairman Greg Barineau, Vice-Chairman Doug Jamieson, Commissioner Sandra Kay Royal, Commissioner Angeli Smith, County Administrator Bill Sawyer, and County Clerk Kathy Bruer. Commissioner Dennis Jones was absent.

ITEM 1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Barineau called the meeting to order and welcomed all guests. Commissioner Angeli Smith gave the Invocation.

ITEM 2. APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA

Vice-Chairman Jamieson made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Commissioner Royal and all were in favor.

ITEM 3. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

Commissioner Smith made a motion to approve the minutes from the June 9th meeting, seconded by Vice-Chairman Jamieson, and all were in favor.

ITEM 4 MR. ED COLLIER, ATTORNEY FOR CARL PEEDE, RE: ROAD ISSUE

Mr. Ed Collier stated that Mr. Peede currently lives in Atlanta but was born and raised in Schley County. The county used to maintain the road where Mr. Peede's land is and he was asking if the county had abandoned the road or if they were just no longer maintaining it. County Administrator Sawyer will review the situation and contact our county attorney. Chairman Barineau said it would be premature to do anything until it has been thoroughly researched. After researching, Mr. Sawyer will be in touch with them.

ITEM 5. APPOINTMENT OF TWO (2) NEW BOARD MEMBERS TO THE SCHLEY COUNTY UTILITY AUTHORITY

After discussion, Vice-Chairman Jamieson made a motion to appoint Sheriff Shane Tondee and Ken Wilson to the Authority, seconded by Commissioner Smith and all were in favor

ITEM 6. APPOINTMENT OF TWO (2) NEW BOARD MEMBERS TO THE ELLAVILLE/SCHLEY COUNTY RECREATION AUTHORITY (RECOMMENDATION LETTER ATTACHED)

After discussion, Vice-Chairman Jamieson made a motion to appoint Justin Renfroe and Jason Hoch to the Authority, seconded by Commissioner Royal and all were in favor

ITEM 7. APPOINTMENT OF NEW BOARD MEMBER TO THE DFACS BOARD (RECOMMENDATION LETTER ATTACHED)

County Administrator Sawyer stated the criteria for serving on this board has changed and the State now dictates some of the qualifications of the members. Due to this change, Mary Storey no longer qualifies. Commissioner Angelia Smith made a motion to appoint Fred Smith to the Board, seconded by Vice-Chairman Jamieson and all were in favor.

ITEM 8. FINANCIAL REPORTS

County Administrator Sawyer presented the financials for June. The Financials were approved.

Item 10. DEPARTMENT REPORTS

Fire Chief Montgomery is on vacation.

Public Works Superintendent Patterson stated they are performing maintenance as needed, and are on their second round of mowing, the high school summer works will quit after next week and the college kids will continue to work until August 7th. As far as water, there was a small fire at the Johnson tank today caused by an electrical short. Otherwise, all is well there.

County Administrator Sawyer stated he will meet next week with some Bond people to discuss a couple issues. One is with the USDA to issue a Bond through the Schley County Utility Authority but we haven't heard back from them. The other is for a new project we are working on. If this project (Project X) goes through, it will be great for our county.

Vice-Chairman Jamieson made a recommendation for Public Works Superintendent Patterson to be pro-active now and begin thinking about how he expects the Water Authority to work with how they currently operate.

Item 11. MOTION TO ADJOURN

Vice Chairman Jamieson made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Commissioner Royal seconded the motion and all were in favor. The meeting adjourned at 6:13 p.m.
