Monday, August 27, 2018

The Schley County Board of Commissioners held a Called meeting August 27, 2018. Those present were: Chairman Greg Barineau, Vice-Chairman Doug Jamieson, Commissioner Bill McClellan, Commissioner Brian Belcher, Commissioner Dennis Jones, County Manager Bill Sawyer, County Clerk, Kathy Bruer and Deputy Clerk, Jessica Ellis.

ITEM 1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Barineau called the meeting to order and welcomed all guests.

ITEM 2. INVOCATION

Commissioner Jones gave the invocation.

ITEM 3. APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA

Vice-Chairman Jamieson made a motion to approve the Agenda as presented, Commissioner McClellan seconded the motion, and all were in favor.

ITEM 4. APPROVAL/DENIAL 2018 MILLAGE RATE

Bill Sawyer stated that we had approved the 2018/2019 proposed budget on June 26th. Bill stated the County Unincorporated is - 12.264, the County Incorporated is 12.264, the School M & O is 16.620 and the School Bond is 2.292. Bill stated the Millage Rate will not increase, and the Chairman is responsible for signing the required documentation. Commissioner Jones made a motion to approve the Millage Rate as presented, seconded by Vice-Chairman Jamieson, and all were in favor.

ITEM 5. APPROVAL/DENIAL RESOLUTION FOR 911 WIRELESS CHARGES

Bill stated House Bill 751 was passed earlier this year authorizing all 911 fees that are collected will come to the counties, rather than going straight to 911. The counties will then, in turn, must write a check to 911. Bill asked for a motion and needed unanimous approval. Vice-Chairman Jamieson made a motion to approve the Resolution for 911 wireless charges, which will allow funds to come to Schley County and funds be dispersed to 911, Commissioner Jones seconded the motion, and everyone was in favor.

Commissioner Jones made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Vice Chairman Jamieson seconded the motion, and all were in favor.
