

**SCHLEY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
EXECUTIVE SESSION
TUESDAY, OCTOBER 13, 2015**

The Schley County Board of Commissioners, went into Executive Session Tuesday, October 13, 2015 at 6:23 p.m. Those present were: Chairman Greg Barineau, Vice-Chairman Doug Jamieson, Commissioner Sandra Kay Royal, Commissioner Angeli Smith and Commissioner Dennis Jones.

Chairman Barineau stated that at the last meeting they had agreed to come back in to Executive Session tonight to discuss Bill Sawyer. He sent some emails with job descriptions and he thought the Putnam County seems to be more in line with what we are looking for. If there is anything to tweak, we can do that. Chairman Barineau opened the table for discussion.

Commissioner Smith said she thinks it's time to go ahead and hire him as the County Administrator; Chairman Barineau stated he will be County Manager. Commissioner Jones asked if we will be moving to a County Manager form of government and Chairman Barineau stated no, we can't change the form of government. We are still County Commissioner run; he will still be accountable to the Board.

Barineau stated before we present to Bill if everyone will take the weekend to review the file and if there is anything you feel that needs to be changed get back to him by Monday. He would like to present to Bill on Monday. Vice-Chairman Jamieson stated, although he wasn't sure if it was in the Putnam County description, he'd like to remove the line that you have to be out of office for a year before you can become the County Manager.

Chairman Barineau will get a clear job description to Bill and ask him to get to Jimmy Skipper to write up a document.

Commissioner Jones asked where we are on hiring someone for Public Works. Chairman Barineau stated that we are still looking to interview and he thinks we have some good applicants. There was discussion about the issues with water around Statham Lake and whether or not we could recoup some of the money we spent for repairs. It was felt the Statute of Limitations has expired.

With that, Commissioner Smith made a motion to adjourn the Executive Session, Vice-Chairman Jamieson seconded the motion and all were in favor.
