

**SCHLEY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**  
**Tuesday, June 21, 2016**

The Schley County Board of Commissioners held their regularly scheduled monthly meeting June 21, 2016. Those present were Chairman Greg Barineau, Vice-Chairman Doug Jamieson, Commissioner Sandra Kay Royal, Commissioner Angeli Smith, Commissioner Dennis Jones, County Manager, Bill Sawyer and County Clerk Kathy Bruer.

**ITEM 1. CALL TO ORDER**

Chairman Barineau called the meeting to order and welcomed all guests. Commissioner Jones opened the meeting with prayer.

**ITEM 2. APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA**

Vice-Chairman Jamieson made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Commissioner Jones and all were in favor.

**ITEM 3. APPROVAL OF THE MAY 10<sup>TH</sup> MINUTES**

Vice-Chairman Jamieson made a motion to approve the minutes from the May 10th meeting, seconded by Commissioner Royal and all were in favor.

**ITEM 4. FINAL ADOPTION OF COURTHOUSE HOURS ORDINANCE**

Chairman Barineau stated that he and Vice-Chairman Jamieson had met with the Constitutional Officers and had addressed their concerns; primarily it was a security issue. Greg stated that they will have a buzzer installed that can be used during the lunch hour and if there are times where there are not two people in an office where lunches can be staggered, the office will be closed during the lunch hour. Commissioner Royal made a motion to adopt the Ordinance, seconded by Vice-Chairman Jamieson and all were in favor.

**ITEM 5. APPROVAL/DENIAL PROPOSED FY 2016/2017 BUDGET**

County Manager Bill Sawyer explained that the budget has two parts. The Special Revenue Funds are completely separate then the regular budget. In addition, the items listed below the total revenue and total expense lines are enterprise accounts and are separate line items. Bill stated he expects the millage rate to stay the same. We will prepare the Budget Ordinance and the Public Hearing notice, which needs to take place next week. We will give the Tax Commissioner and Tax Assessor a copy of the budget so they can begin work on the five-year budget that must appear in the paper. Bill stated that this is a workable document so it can be amended. If we see that the Digest would cause an increase in the millage rate we will look at decreasing the reserve expense so that we would not have to do that. Bill stated that another unknown is what will be required from us with USDA. We can always adjust the Revenue and Expense projections. Bill stated that we will get an email out to the commissioners when the Public Hearing will be. Vice-Chairman Jamieson made a motion to approve the tentative budget, seconded by Commissioner Royal and all were in favor.

**ITEM 6. APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION TO ADOPT SCHLEY COUNTY/ELLAVILLE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN 2017-2026 (MANDATED)**

Commissioner Royal made a motion to approve the Resolution to adopt the Schley County/Ellaville Comprehensive Plan 2016-2027, seconded by Commissioner Smith and the motion was carried.

**ITEM 7. APPROVAL RE-ADOPTING SCHLEY COUNTY SERVICE DELIVERY STRATEGY (MANDATED)**

Commissioner Royal made a motion to approve the re-adopting of the Schley County Service Delivery Strategy, seconded by Commissioner Smith and all were in favor.

Chairman Barineau stated that Bill Sawyer had mentioned to him that he had received a call from the City concerning adding alcohol sales to the November ballot. Greg stated the County does not want to participate.

Bill Sawyer stated that he had received some calls about removing fluoride from our water treatment. Greg stated he would prefer that those individuals come to the commissioner's meeting and discuss their reasoning and in the meantime, the commissioners should do their own research. Commissioner Royal stated she had research and would share with the rest.

Bill Sawyer reminded the commissioners that there is an ACCG class tomorrow at SGTC from 10-2 and that we are hosting an Open House at the renovated courthouse on Thursday.

**ITEM 9. MOTION TO ADJOURN**

Vice Chairman Jamieson made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Commissioner Royal seconded and all were in favor.
