

SCHLEY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
Tuesday, August 9, 2016

The Schley County Board of Commissioners held their regularly scheduled monthly meeting August 9, 2016. Those present were Chairman Greg Barineau, Vice-Chairman Doug Jamieson, Commissioner Sandra Kay Royal, Commissioner Angeli Smith, Commissioner Dennis Jones, County Manager, Bill Sawyer and County Clerk Kathy Bruer.

ITEM 1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Barineau called the meeting to order and welcomed all guests. Commissioner Jones opened the meeting with prayer.

ITEM 2. APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA

Commissioner Royal made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Commissioner Smith and all were in favor.

ITEM 3. APPROVAL OF THE JULY 12TH MINUTES

Commissioner Smith made a motion to approve the minutes from the July 12th meeting, seconded by Vice-Chairman Jamieson and all were in favor.

ITEM 4. UPDATE ON ZONING

Bill Sawyer stated that we have received three housing permits, two additions and seven inspections.

ITEM 5. APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION FOR WORKERS COMP TO BE INCLUSIVE

Bill presented a Resolution that is all inclusive of other Resolutions and will supersede previous Resolutions. Commissioner Smith made a motion to approve the Resolution, seconded by Vice-Chairman Jamieson and all were in favor.

ITEM 6. APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION FOR RVRC/BARNES TO COLLECT 911 FEES

We have been asked to join a lawsuit brought about by Attorney Roy Barnes based on an audit that will allocate funds collected from individual landline for E911 fees. Each county would receive 66% of collected funds. Vice-Chairman Jamieson made a motion to approve the lawsuit, seconded by Commissioner Jones and all were in favor.

ITEM 7. DEPARTMENT REPORTS

Duane gave an update on Fire/EMS stating their calls had picked up some in July. EMS responded to 60 calls and they had 13 fire calls. He also stated that they had their first community paramedicine visit. Upon a patient discharge with CVA or diabetes, from the hospital, they have 72 hours to go make a home health visit. They will go over the discharge papers and meds to make sure the patient understands what they are supposed to do. Mark Royal stated Public Works had a good month, they are in their second round of mowing, they have some minor breakdowns and Robert Hale is out on W/C.

ITEM 11. COUNTY MANAGER REPORT

Bill stated we will open Bids at 2:00 on Thursday, August 11th for the striping project. This will be at no cost to the county. We are applying for a grant for the retention pond on Old 19 to help with Lowery Road issues and Colby Hudson is leaving the county. Art Barfield will be moving to the Water department.

ITEM 12. FINANCIAL REPORTS

Bill Sawyer presented the financials. He stated that Water arrears are: \$5700 and Sanitation arrears are \$46,000.

Pam Register stated that we are on track with the digest; the numbers should be approved Thursday night and she should have her figures on Monday. She also stated she has been having problems with her credit card machine. Greg asked her to get with LeAndra at Peoples Bank.

Commissioner Smith gave an update on the conference she attended in July.

ITEM 13. MOTION TO ADJOURN

Vice-Chairman Jamieson made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Commissioner Royal seconded and all were in favor.
