

SCHLEY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
Tuesday, November 14, 2017

The Schley County Board of Commissioners held their regularly scheduled monthly meeting November 14, 2017. Those present were Chairman Greg Barineau, Vice-Chairman Doug Jamieson, Commissioner Dennis Jones, Commissioner Bill McClellan, Commissioner Brian Belcher, and County Manager Bill Sawyer.

ITEM 1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Barineau called the meeting to order and welcomed all guests.

ITEM 2. INVOCATION

Commissioner Jones gave the invocation.

ITEM 3. APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA

Vice-Chairman Jamieson a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Commissioner Jones and all were in favor.

ITEM 4. APPROVAL OF THE OCTOBER 10TH MINUTES

Commissioner Jones made a motion to approve the minutes from the October 10th meeting. Vice-Chairman Jamieson seconded the motion, and all were in favor.

ITEM 5. ANNUAL GEORGIA FORESTRY REPORT

Brent McCarty presented his annual Forestry update.

ITEM 6: APPOINTMENT OF SCHLEY COUNTY LIBRARY BOARD MEMBER TO REPLACE ANN DILLARD

Bill stated that Ann Dillard is stepping down from the Library Board and suggested that Gloria Jordan be approved as the replacement. Vice-Chairman Jamieson made a motion and was seconded by Commissioner Belcher; all were in favor.

ITEM 7: UPDATE ON SVE SYSTEM & CONTRACT

Bill stated the SVE is still in process. We still have an approximate obligation of \$85,000. As soon as they are finished we will request the 80% reimbursement.

ITEM 8: DEPARTMENT REPORTS

Public Works - Mark Royal stated they are continuing to work on all projects and things seem to be okay for now.

Water – Art Barfield stated they are continuing to work with unpaid customers; two taps pending, locked 17 meters and unlocked 15. Has completed 17 locates; had three new addresses.

Zoning – Bill stated two doublewides have moved in and there were six inspections.

ITEM 12. COUNTY MANAGER REPORT

Bill stated that we are beginning to receive tax money, so we will not be borrowing any TAN money. All department heads are still watching their expenses and trying not to spend any unnecessary funds. Our Thanksgiving luncheon will be on November 22nd and hopes all the Board members can attend.

ITEM 10. FINANCIAL REPORTS

Bill Sawyer presented the financials.

ITEM 11. MOTION TO ADJOURN

Commissioner Jones made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Commissioner Belcher seconded the motion, and all were in favor.
